REFERRAL GUIDE FOR EMPLOYER



Who is a good fit for the program?

Below are the guidelines to help you determine if your employee would qualify for the United Way's Drive-to-Thrive Program. The program is referral based, however, all applications will be reviewed by a committee before approval.

Individual must currently be employed.

This program is specifically for individuals who need to maintain their current employment or improve their employment status.

Individual must have an established relationship with the referring employer.

Candidates should demonstrate a commitment to work towards self-sufficiency. Increased accountability helps ensure success for the client.

The referred employee must be able to repay their loan.

Our program helps individuals acquire low-interest vehicle loans at competitive rates. They must show that they will be able to afford monthly car and insurance payments for the duration of the loan.

The employee must agree to financial planning and budgeting workshops.

The workshops will help create a good working relationship between the individual and the program manager. They will also ensure the candidate is successful at maintaining their monthly payments and other commitments.

Upon approval, the individual must check in with the program manager.

Check-ins must be made at least once a month and may be done in-person, over the phone, or via video conference.
